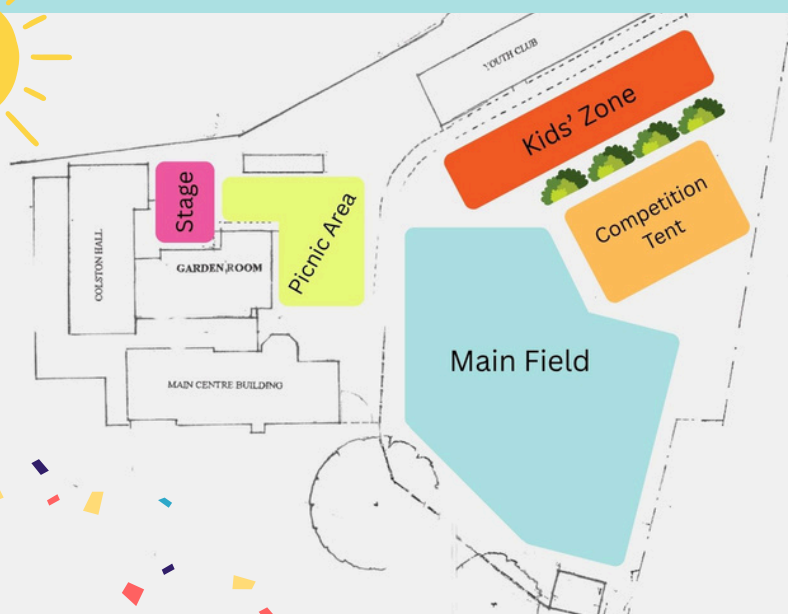
Welcome from Marcia Bell (Chairman of the GXCA)

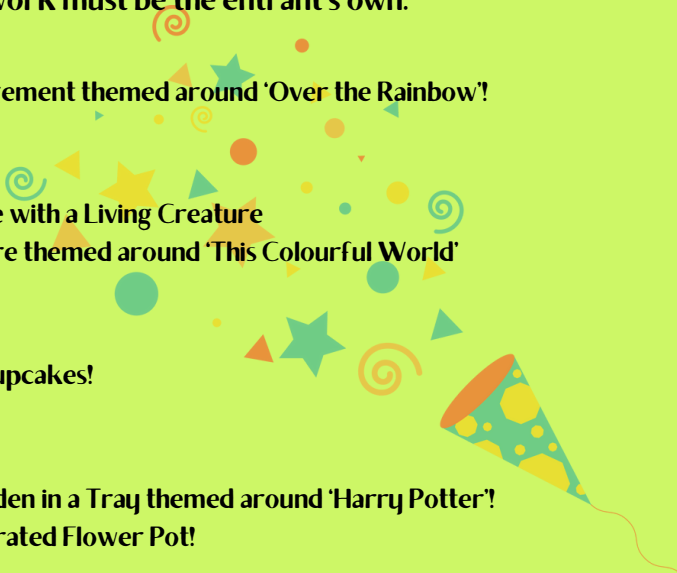

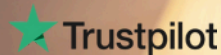

Fruit Loaf Recipe

For the Best 'Non-Baker' in the Family Competition!

Ingredients

450g Self Raising Flour
125g Caster Sugar
1 tsp Baking Powder
1 tsp Mixed Spice
A Pinch of Salt

125g Unsalted Butter
450g Mixed Fruit and Peel
1 tsp Bicarbonate of Soda
250ml Milk

Method

1. Preheat the oven to 150 C / 300 F
2. In a bowl, sift together the flour, sugar, baking powder, mixed spice, and salt.
3. Rub in the butter until it looks like breadcrumbs, then fold in the mixed fruit.
4. Stir the bicarbonate of soda into the milk and add to the mixture. Stir until well combined.
5. Spoon the mixture into a loaf tin and bake for 1 hour 45 minutes.
6. Allow to cool then turn out of the tin.
