
#### Welcome from Marcia Bell (Chairman of the GXCA)





#### Fruit Loaf Recipe

For the Best 'Non-Baker' in the Family Competition!

#### **Ingredients**

450g Self Raising Flour 125g Caster Sugar 1 tsp Baking Powder 1tsp Mixed Spice A Pinch of Salt

125g Unsalted Butter 450g Mixed Fruit and Peel 1tsp Bicarbonate of Soda 250ml Milk

#### **Method**

- 1. Preheat the oven to 150 C / 300 F
- 2. In a bowl, sift together the flour, sugar, baking powder, mixed spice, and salt.
- 3. Rub in the butter until it looks like breadcrumbs, then fold in the mixed fruit.
- 4. Stir the bicarbonate of soda into the milk and add to the mixture. Stir until well combined.
- 5. Spoon the mixture into a loaf tin and bake for 1 hour 45 minutes.
- 6. Allow to cool then turn out of the tin.
